Thank you for your response to the local authority's request concerning the wearing of face coverings and remaining on the school site for as short a time as possible. Your co-operation is much appreciated.

We are glad that the school is continuing to function with some sort of normality and that the children are able to access their learning with as little disruption as possible. At this stage, it is clear that a number of children are needing extra help and support in order to close a gap, accentuated by the period of school closure; staff are working hard to give this extra support or intervention, and may be asking parents to give some extra support with this at home as well, so that these children can do some catching up.

Each class is now running some activities and work on Google Classroom, and it is really important that parents support their children to access this, to get used to viewing and completing work on it, so that in the event of any closure, learning can continue smoothly. If you are having any difficulty with access, please email or speak to your child's class teacher. It is also important that any children who may be absent due to awaiting a test, or self-isolating, continue to access this work, so that more gaps do not develop or become wider.

We appreciate all the support which parents are giving to their children at this time.


